EPISODE #13 :

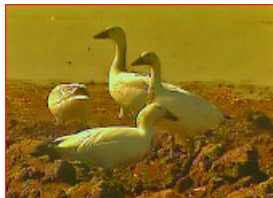
THE ELEPHANT / THE TURTLE / THE JUMPER HORSE
